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

Meet The Speaker Rondaline Craft

Topic: "InfraGard and Cyber Terrorism"

Special Agent Craft serves as the Counterintelligence Strategic Partnership, InfraGard and Crisis Response Coordinator for the Austin Resident Agency, San Antonio Division of the FBI. The CI Strategic Partnership Program facilitates collaboration with key private sector stake holders of critical technology targeted by foreign adversaries. InfraGard promotes ongoing dialogue and timely communication between its members, the key equity holders within the eighteen categories of critical infrastructure, and the FBI. InfraGard members gain access to information that enables them to protect their assets and in turn give information to the government that facilitates its responsibilities to prevent and address all threats to the United States. The FBI's Crisis Response Program is designed to strengthen the preparedness and capabilities of the FBI to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from threatened or actual terrorist attacks, major investigations, critical incidents, catastrophic natural disasters, and special events.

Prior to transferring to the San Antonio Division, SA Craft served the Assistant Director, Cyber Division, as a member of his Executive Staff. SA Craft facilitated the Division's Congressional liaison, to include the preparation of FBI executive testimony to the Hill, analyzed and responded to proposed legislation and policy, coordinated with the Department of Homeland Security's cyber security efforts, and interfaced with the White House regarding the overall strategic response to the Advanced Persistent Threat.

From 2007 to 2009, SA Craft served as the first FBI representative to the President's Intelligence Advisory Board (PIAB). An element of the Executive Office of the President, the PIAB advises the President on intelligence issues of White House interest. The PIAB, through its Intelligence Oversight Board, advises on the legality of intelligence activities. SA Craft managed the day-to-day activities of the IOB, and served as Staff Lead on two independent studies requested by the President George W. Bush.

Before the PIAB, SA Craft was a Supervisory Special Agent in the FBI's Richmond Division, where she simultaneously established two high priority FBI programs: Counterintelligence and Field Intelligence. The Richmond Counterintelligence program included the initiation of the Richmond Division Counterintelligence Working Group and the CI Strategic Partnership Initiative, both critical to implementing the FBI's National Counterintelligence Strategy. The Field Intelligence Program implements the intelligence cycle at an operational level to better collect local intelligence and disseminate it to the US intelligence community and decision makers in Washington, D.C.

From 2002 to 2004, SA Craft served as a Supervisory Special Agent at FBI Headquarters, Counterintelligence Division, Counterespionage Section. In this capacity, SA Craft provided operational program management to numerous counterespionage investigations throughout the United States, as well as subject matter expert briefings to senior FBI management, DOJ leadership, members of the US intelligence community, Foreign Service counterparts, private sector executives and other Bureau personnel. Upon entering on duty with the FBI, SA Craft served in the New Orleans Division investigating domestic terrorism, white-collar crime and public corruption.

Prior to joining the FBI, SA Craft was a litigation attorney in private practice in San Antonio, Texas. SA Craft earned a B.A. in Government, with a minor in Business, from the University of Texas at Austin and received her J.D. from St. Mary's University School of Law.
