President's Letter:

FEI Columbus Members and Sponsors:

Happy 2024! The turning over of the year always affords an opportunity to reflect on what positive changes have taken place in the past year, and also on what one's opportunities and goals are for the coming year.

Here is that snapshot for FEI Central Ohio.

In 2023,

- We added three new board committee members, as I mentioned in previous newsletters —
 Brandy Raabe, Mike Sedlock, and Chris Watson. Each comes with years of experience, and I
 am grateful to them for their willingness to lead and add their unique perspectives.
- We had turnover in our chapter sponsors. This evolution is at the same time (a) inevitable, (b) sad for the relationships that have changed, and (c) an opportunity to develop new and deeper relationships. To those points, since January 2023, we have added Footprint Capital, FocusCFO, and Huntington Bank as chapter sponsors. The reasons for these new sponsors aligning themselves with FEI Central Ohio are unique to their firms and the changing nature of our chapter. Of note is that Huntington was a sponsor previously, and decided to re-engage. And members of FocusCFO have been affiliated with the chapter for years. To all three of these newer sponsors, we welcome your deeper involvement in making FEI Central Ohio a great place to network for all involved. In that same time, Key Bank, Schneider Downs, and BMO Harris made the decision to stop sponsoring the chapter. Each situation was also unique, a result of leadership transitions and changes in firm operations. We miss their involvement and of course wish them nothing but success.

• Chapter finances remained on solid ground. We don't often talk about finances, but as we turn the year I want you to be confident that the Board continues to ensure the chapter is fiscally sound and able to continue its mission. We ended the year with a cash balance that approximates a year's worth of expenditures for events and administration. This is right in line with our goals, and compares with recent high and low points of 0.5 to 2.0 times that figure. You may recall the during COVID we built up a cash cushion as live events were shut down, and that in response to that we deferred chapter sponsor invoicing for 6 months to burn off that cushion. We ended 2023 right where we want to be.

Our 2024 goals remain similar to what they have been:

- **Grow Membership and Engagement.** We want to continue growing our membership ranks. You may not be aware, but our chapter is a few years into a pretty significant generational turnover in membership, with many long time members retiring out, while we slowly add new members. We want this to continue and gather steam. Equally important, we want to have that membership engaged by attending meetings/events and interacting with each other and sponsors. Engagement could also take the form of additional members stepping up to get involved with the board.
- **Put on excellent programming.** The type that makes people want to attend in person. We continue to look for opportunities to make programs more engaging, focusing less on technical educational content and more on fun open networking. The Hylant Risk Landscape and Bourbon Tasting from October 2023 is a good example of this. We're looking forward to more of this. And as always, your ideas are welcome!

That's really it. We could add a proliferation of different goals. But we are really focused on those things that most directly impact the core mission of FEI Central Ohio – making this a great place for engaged financial leaders to thrive.

We welcome and encourage **YOUR** engagement in 2024. Our next few sessions are highlighted elsewhere in this newsletter. Why not sign up and come join in the fun?
